MREplus™ Entry Screen

MREplus™ Features:

1. Intuitive, easy-to-understand menus.
2. Daylight Mode will darken the buttons so they are clearly seen in bright sunlight.
3. Extended comment allows free form comments to be entered.
4. Statistics Screen displays the number of accounts that have been read and unread along with the total number of accounts, and date/time.
5. Search for Accounts by Last Name, Service Address, Meter Number, and Unread Meters.
6. The “Found Meter” feature allows the meter reader to enter information about meters “found” on a particular route that may have been improperly documented.
7. Audible and visual High/Low Reading Warnings.
8. Previous Reading Displayed.
9. Each customer’s account is displayed automatically.
